- What career or job do you want to have when you grow up? Read a book about it.
- Read a book about your favorite season.
- Read a book that looks really cool!
- Pick a book shelf in the library and read the very first book on it.

- Read a book you remember from when you were younger.
- Read a book about a state that you've never been to.
- Read a book about someone that is different from you.
- What is a movie you like? Find the book and read it!
